




Prior to the transition to online/remote work due to COVID-19, did you have any experience with working in an online environment (at Hancock or other institutions)?




### Are you currently working remotely (e.g., from home)?










What is your experience like since transitioning to online/remote work?




In general, how much time are you spending doing your routine daily tasks since the transition to online/remote work due to COVID-19?



Do you miss the social interaction from working with people face-toface?




Since Allan Hancock College adopted social distancing measures, how well are you able to access services at the college that are important to your work?



How concerned are you about the COVID-19 pandemic and the associated disruptions in your daily life?






