
Leading from the Middle 2015

- In fall 2014 the Spanish program review identified a retention/success gap between online and face to face courses – they wanted to disaggregate further.
- As a result, investigation by the Research Office shows this same gap for the entire college.



Ready...Set...


As a result of attending the Leading from the Middle Academy, participants will be able to do the following:

Short term goals

 Town hall meeting, student surveys, planning retreat, all staff day, 3SP analyst hire, implement EDTC 300 course

Medium term goals

 Framework to track EDTC 300 students, establish baseline of faculty and student DL awareness, create meaningful SLOs to track data/progress, develop DL course evaluation mechanism

Long term goals

 Increase overall, including equity group, DL retention and success by 10% in ten years, institutionalize DL support for faculty/staff, increase faculty and student DL awareness by 10% over ten years
