What is Santa Barbara Vision Care (SBVC)?

SBVC provides free comprehensive eye exams, eyeglasses, medications, and medically necessary eye surgery to qualified low-income individuals.

Who qualifies for these services?

To qualify you must be a Santa Barbara or Ventura County resident. Be classified as low-income and not have vision care coverage, or qualify for any federal or state funded insurance programs (Medicare, Medi-Cal, Healthy Families, etc). Services are available in Santa Maria, Goleta, Ventura, and Oxnard. SBVC welcomes both children and adults.
