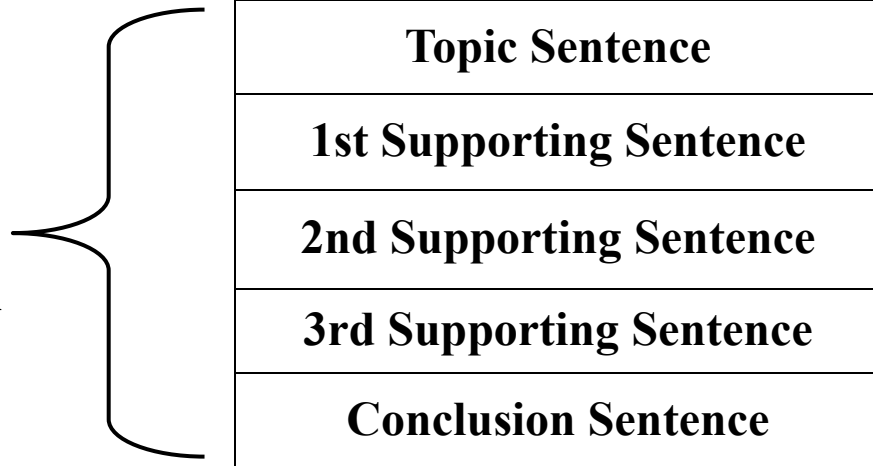


PARTS OF A PARAGRAPH

Parts of a Paragraph

| TOPIC SENTENCE: | <p>This sentence tells the reader the main idea, or what the paragraph will be about.</p> <p>Ex: There are several health hazards linked to the eating of fast food.</p> |
| 1st SUPPORTING SENTENCE: | <p>This sentence gives specific details relating to the main idea.</p> <p>Ex: Eating fast food is linked to a higher risk of obesity, depression, and digestive issues.</p> |
| 2nd SUPPORTING SENTENCE: | <p>This sentence gives another specific detail relating to the main idea.</p> <p>Ex: Also, there is a greater risk of heart disease, type 2 diabetes, cancer, and early death.</p> |
| 3rd SUPPORTING SENTENCE: | <p>This sentence gives more specific details relating to the main idea.</p> <p>Ex: Further, research shows that even one fast food meal can lead to increased blood pressure, a drop in blood sugar, and increased inflammation throughout the body.</p> |
| CONCLUSION SENTENCE: | <p>This sentence refers to the topic sentence and sums up the main idea of the paragraph.</p> <p>Ex: Clearly, eating fast food is an unhealthy habit and should be avoided.</p> |
